

Consent Policy

Consent Policy

1. This policy covers all personal data that CEME Conference Centre process on the understanding we must obtain consent when no other lawful basis applies. We are responsible for obtaining consent from a data subject under advisement from Data Protection Officer DPO/GDPR Owner.
2. The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) says consent is “any freely given, specific, informed and unambiguous indication of the data subject's wishes by which he or she, by a statement or by a clear affirmative action, signifies agreement to the processing of personal data relating to him or her”.
3. The GDPR defines a child as anyone under the age of 16 years old, although this may be lowered to 13 by individual Member State law. The processing of personal data of a child is only lawful if parental or custodian consent has been obtained. The DPO/GDPR Owner makes reasonable efforts to verify in such cases that consent is given or authorised by the holder of parental responsibility over the child.
4. CEME Conference Centre provide a clear privacy notice in plain language wherever personal data is collected and retain evidence of consent forms as appropriate for:-
 - general consent for processing personal data
 - explicit consent for the processing of sensitive personal data
 - consent for the use of personal data for specific purposes
 - consent for the use of personal data relating to specific contracts
5. We inform data subjects of the right to withdraw consent before giving consent and record the giving of this information
